Work with SCORE and your local Small Business Development Center for free advice	Visit www.score.org to find a business mentor and valuable small business information
Choose the legal form of entity	Work with a business attorney and a CPA
Choose a business name	Visit www.uspto.gov/trademark and perform a TESS search to quickly determine if your business name is already trademarked
Register the business name with the Secretary of State	Work with your CPA
Register a domain name	Visit www.instantdomainsearch.com to verify if your chosen domain name is available
Set up the legal documents	Work with an attorney
Apply for an EIN - form SS-4 with the IRS - work with your CPA. Keep the letter from the IRS which states your EIN forever	Give copies to your attorney and CPA
Apply for applicable business licenses	Work with your CPA
Set up your bank account	If you do not already have a banker, work with your CPA for referrals
Set up your credit card account	
Set up your accounting system	Work with your CPA
Set up your compensation structure and how to remit the taxes	Work with your CPA
Set up your payroll system if applicable	Work with your CPA
Create your visual identity (logo and branding)	Work with a brand designer
Set up your website and social media profiles	Work with a social media marketing team
